FINANCIAL PEACE UNIVERSITY—Led by Matt & Kara Nalley

Financial Peace University will show you how to get rid of debt, manage your money, spend and save wisely, and much more, all through a biblically based curriculum. This course is designed for those who are looking to better manage finances, who desire to do it God's way. You can even come for a refresher if you have taken the course before. BIBLE STUDY: 1 & 2 PETER —Led by Pastor Mark Gearig

More and more it becomes clear that we live in a world that is hostile and opposed to God and His people. But this is nothing new. Christians throughout all of history have experienced persecution and ridicule for their faith. This was especially true for the first generation of Christians. In these two letters, Peter gives great encouragement and insight to how we are to respond to such hostility and live out our lives faithfully as God's people. We will utilize the Bible only for this study. This class is led by Pastor Mark Gearig and meets **6:30-7:30pm**.

YOU DON'T HAVE TO TEACH PEOPLE HOW TO SIN —Led by Jim Minton

In a fun and informative video format, Jim will share 13 principles that have helped him to improve his kids and himself and lead him to "Build the Home and Change the World". This course is appropriate for all ages but especially lays out a game plan for parents raising children. Barb Ninnemann said about the class a year ago "the format was not a traditional one.....very informative, inspirational, educational and entertaining." There are no required materials. Led by Jim Minton, the class meets 6:30-7:30pm.

SEE THROUGH THE SCRIPTURES –Led by Chris Schuette
