

Preparing for Worship

As we continue forward in this season of Lent, we journey together as we follow Jesus toward the cross; toward the death that ultimately brings resurrection life. We look to our Father to draw us close to Him, through His Son Jesus. We ask for His help in surrendering to Him the areas of our lives where we are struggling, where we need change. Whatever is before you, we pray that you persevere through your struggle throughout this season.

An eyewitness account is always best. This is because an eyewitness experiences an event with all their senses. As a result, he or she is able to give the most accurate and full picture of what happened. However, each eyewitness account of the same event is unique, because each person has a different perspective. Each person experiences the event in a slightly different way. Each unique perspective leads to a fuller and deeper understanding of the event and its impact.

This season of lent we look at the events of Jesus' suffering and death from the unique perspective of six well-known and sometimes notorious eyewitnesses. Through their testimonies we will be invited to feel their emotions and see through their eyes as we travel from the garden of Gethsemane to the foot of the cross. In doing so, we will be lead to a more profound understanding of the great love and compassion that is displayed in the suffering and death of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Our Belief: Receiving the Lord's Supper

The Apostle Paul wrote, "A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup." (1 Corinthians 11:28) In order to examine yourself before attending the Lord's Supper, when offered, ask yourself the following questions:

- 1. Do I believe I am a sinner, and am I sorry for my sins?
- 2. Do I believe Jesus, by His death, offers me forgiveness for all my sins?
- 3. Do I believe I receive the body and blood of Jesus in and with the bread and wine? (They are not merely symbolically present.)
- 4. Do I truly desire to turn from my sinful ways?

If you are able to answer "yes" to these questions, we invite you to join us for the Lord's Supper, when offered. Children and adults who cannot answer affirmatively are invited and encouraged to come forward for a blessing but should refrain from receiving the bread and wine.*

*For those who are unable, or prefer not to consume wine, cups with white grape juice are located in the center of the communion trays.
